

Kadrmas, Lee & Jackson, Inc. (KLJ) began as L.W. Veigel Consulting Engineering in 1938 in the basement of the Stark County Courthouse in Dickinson, ND. Staff and offices were added over the years and the firm's name was officially changed to Kadrmas, Lee & Jackson, Inc. in 1984. With 80 years serving the engineering industry, what began as a small company working across the Dakotas, is now involved in engineering infrastructure across the nation.

In 2017 KLJ was hired to conduct a high accuracy Digital Terrain Model (DTM) for the five-mile stretch of congested, high traffic area of I-35W, which the team did overnight. This avoided delays for travelers, increased safety, and kept the project moving. The project was awarded a 2017 Minnesota American Council of Engineering Companies Honor award for engineering excellence.

Today, KLJ is a leading consulting engineer for the transportation industry.
