

Minnesota Asphalt Pavement Association (MAPA) was incorporated on January 13, 1943, as the Minnesota Bituminous Pavers Association. The association experienced a period of inactivity due to WVII, but was then reincorporated in 1953, thus, this year marks the 65th anniversary of MAPA's continuous operation. MAPA represents about 96 percent of Minnesota's asphalt industry - approximately 23 asphalt producers along with 9 asphalt non-producers and 100+ associate members who supply materials to the asphalt pavement industry. The association represents members' interests regarding items involving transportation, the environment, and legislation."

Today, MAPA holds a leadership role in encouraging responsible funding for transportation, and is a leading association for the transportation industry.
