



Founded in 1946 as the Barton Contracting Company, the firm that would later become Tiller Corporation, began as a road construction company focused on building Minnesota's interstate highway system. For roughly two decades, Barton Contracting Company was involved in every stage of highway construction, until highway construction activities began to slow down in the late 1960s. From then on the company shifted its focus to becoming a materials supplier, and built an asphalt cement storage facility in St.Paul under the name Barton Enterprises, Inc. Tiller Corporation was founded in 1981 as a holding company for Barton Enterprises.

Today, Tiller Corporation operates over 15 aggregate operations and 10 asphalt plants throughout the Metro, and is a leading contractor of the transportation industry.
