Appropriation for States, Tribal Governments, Local Gov'ts	\$150,000,000
Specific Allocation: DC, PR, US Virgin Islands, American Samoa, and Northern Mariana Islands	\$3,000,000
Specific Allocation: Payments to Tribal Governments	<u>\$8,000,000</u>
Balance: Allocated to 50 States	<b>\$139,000,000</b>

**State Allocation Amount**

- States receive an amount equal to the state's population divided by the total U.S. population for the 50 states (excluding D.C.), multiplied by the balance allocated to the states
- No state shall receive less than \$1.25 billion

**Division of a State Allocation**

*Local government allocation within a state*

Local governments with a population in excess of 500,000 are eligible for an amount equal to the product of:

- The local government population divided by state population
- 45%
- The state's allocation

*The state government allocation*

The state government receives an amount equal to the state's original allocation minus the amount allocated to a state's local governments >500,000

**Uses of Money from Coronavirus Relief Fund**

Source: P.L. 116-136 , Sec 601, paragraph (d)

States, Local Governments, and Tribal Governments must use funds to cover costs that:  
"(1) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);  
(2) were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of the date of the enactment of this section for the State or government; and  
(3) were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020."
