Workforce Development Division of DEED

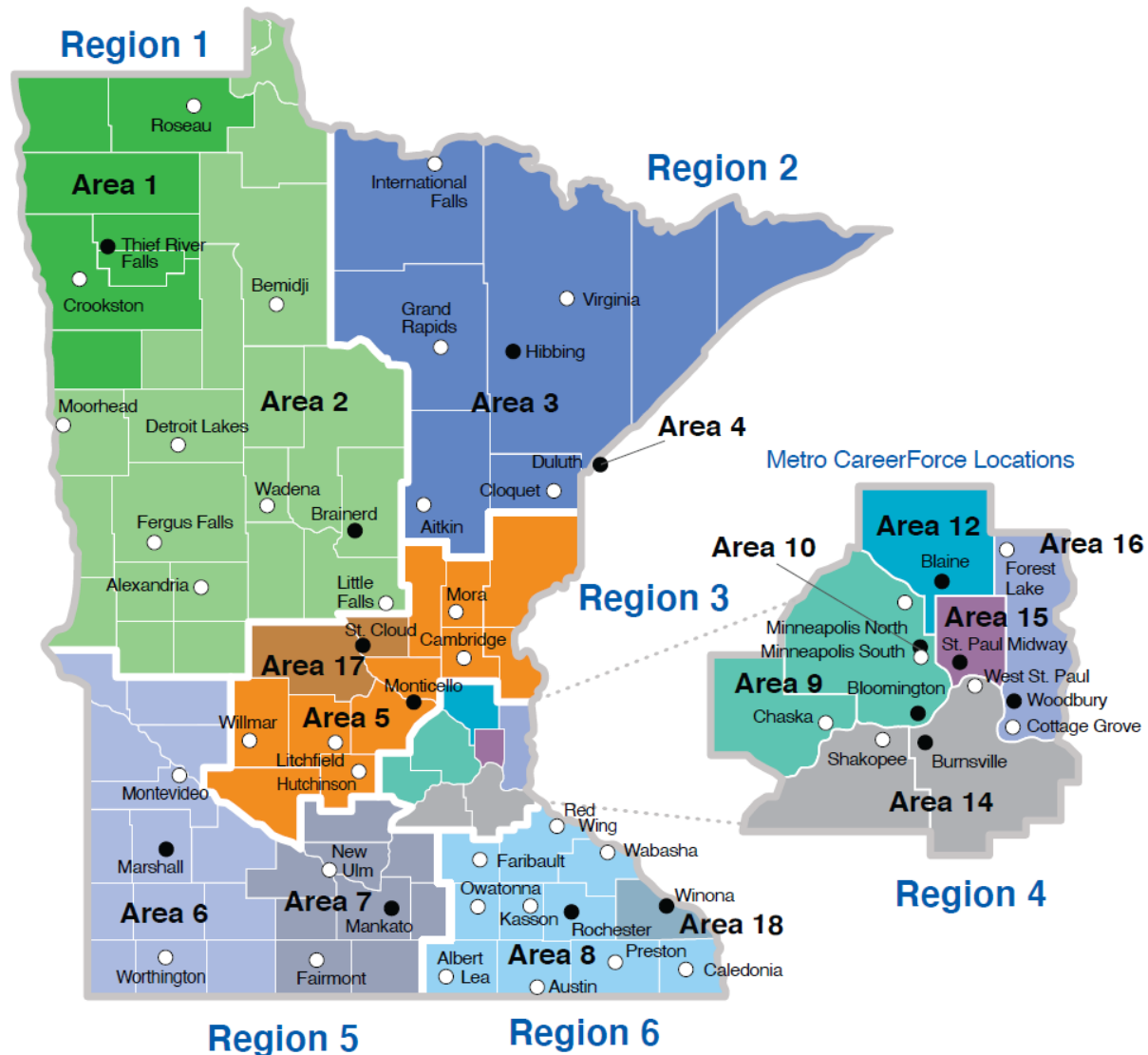
- Oversees a variety of federal and state workforce programs

 - **Title III:** Employment Service program under the Wagner-Peyser Act
 - **Title IV:** Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)

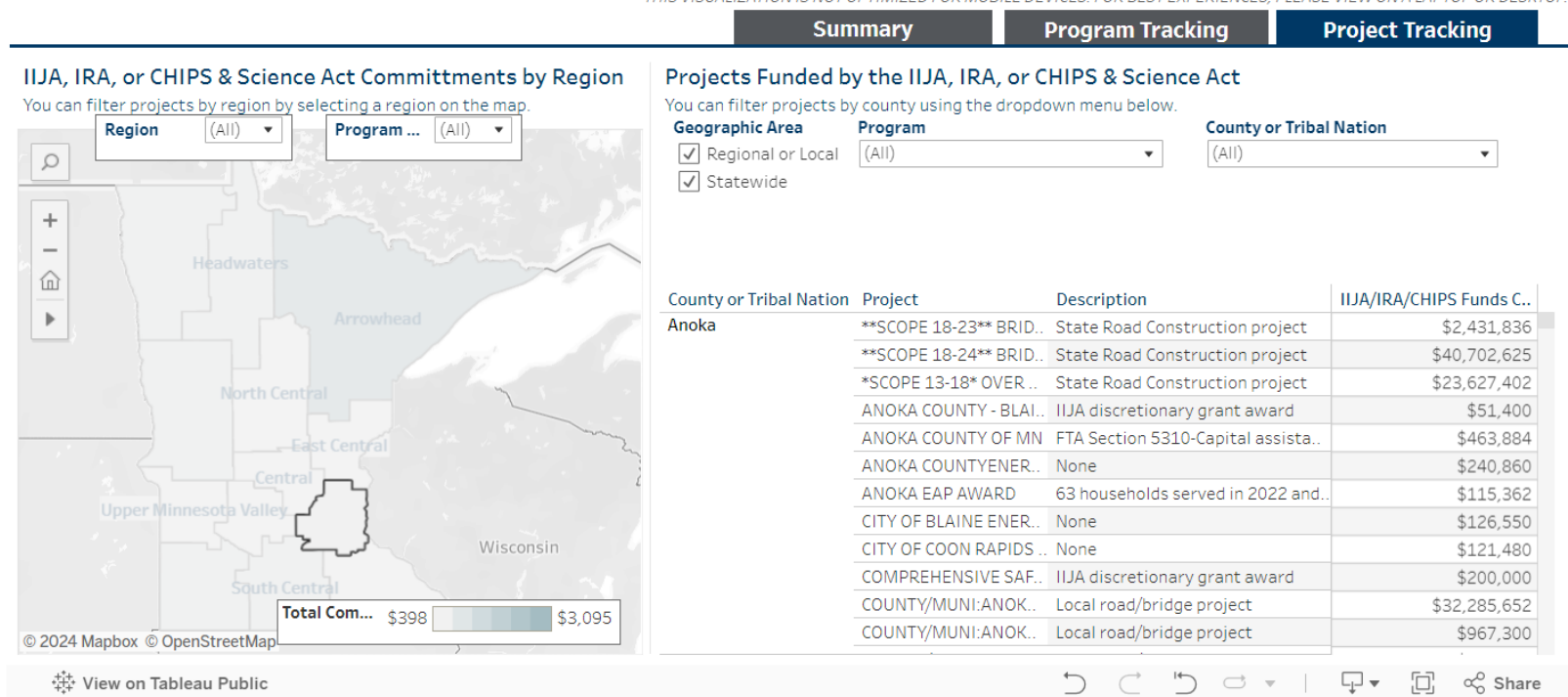
